Please remember to exercise your right to vote in the August 6th Primary Election and the November 5 General Election. You may vote 3 main ways:

- 1.) Absentee Ballot- sent out via mail to people on the Permanent Ballot AV list.

From The Treasurer.... Summer taxes are due July 1 thru September 16 without penalty. After September 16, a 1% per month or part thereof will be added to the unpaid base amount until March 1, 2024. You may pay your summer taxes by mail, drop box in the door, or I am at the Township offices on Thursday evenings from 6-8 PM and Fridays from 10:00 AM-4:00 PM. You may leave a message anytime on the answering machine at 231 378-2616 and I will return your call.

For those of you who have a mortgage company or bank paying your taxes (escrow), you will see a pink sticker on your tax bill that says a copy of the bill was sent to your Mortgage Company but the original is being sent to you. For those who pay their taxes by mail, keep the bottom part of your tax bill as a receipt or if you would like a receipt mailed, please send a addressed stamped envelope.



From the Assessor

Michigan assessing requires routine property visits to verify and update property record information. To do this, the Assessor will conduct inspections and will include an outside measurement of the buildings on the property and taking up to date photos. CODE RED

Manistee County has a free service to all residents. It is CODE RED, an alert system that allows anyone to sign up for that will cover any type of emergency situation. The emergency alert system allows agencies, like the Sheriffs Department or Emergency Management to share information in situations like wild fires, evacuations, severe storms, shootings, or during a search for someone. Sign up is voluntary and you may get alerts through a phone app, texts, phone calls and emails.

You are required to get a burning permit prior to burning brush/debris in Michigan. You may go to the internet to www.mich.gov/burnpermit or you may call 1-866-922-2876, and an automated voice will ask what County you are calling about and give you an answer.

This is a good time to get rid of automotive products, paint products, electronics, cleaners, pharmaceuticals, small appliances and other items.
