*There is no Early Voting for this election as this is a local election.
Only State and Federal Elections are required to have Early Voting available.*

Polls will be open 7am-8pm.

You may also request to vote with an Absentee Ballot:

Online and mail requests for an absentee ballot must be received by your township or city clerk no later than 5 p.m. the Friday before the election. If you are already registered at your current address, you can request an absent voter ballot in person at your clerk's office anytime up to 4 p.m. on the day prior to the election.

If you are registering to vote or updating your address by appearing at your clerk's office on Election Day, you can request an absent voter ballot at the same time you register. If you request your AV ballot the day before the election or on Election Day, you must vote the ballot in the clerk's office.
